## **Johnson Family Cemetery**

Township 12 South, Range 4 West, Section 20

Location: At the Dodge City exit on Interstate 65 (exit 299), turn on Highway 69 toward Jasper; travel seven miles to Bremen; just past the Bremen community, near mile marker 227, look for a small dirt lane to the right; at the time of the survey a wooden sign was there which said "Johnson Cemetery;" cemetery is a few dozen yards back in the woods in sight of the highway. Surveyed 5 Sep 2004.

**Johnson, B.F.,** 24 Aug 1845 - 21 Jun 1906, [Benjamin Franklin Johnson was a Private in Company G of the 8th Alabama Cavalry, CSA; Alabama Confederate Pension Applications]

**Johnson, Evaline,** 15 Jun 1822 - 16 Jan 1908

**Johnson, George,** 14 Aug 1818 - 3 May 1890

**Johnson, J.M.,** 20 Jan 1868 - 11 Jan 1891, [broken monument]

**Johnson, Mary E.,** 9 Dec 1845 - 21 Dec 1931

**Mayfiel, Routhan,** wife of Leroy Mayfiel, 1847 - 11 Mar 1880, aged 33 yr., [the "D" is left off "Mayfield" on this monument]

Parker, Martha, 1843 - 1864

Parker, Walter, 1850 - 1868

Hollis, J. Birten, son of Thomas and Nancy Hollis, 1882 - 1888

King, Infant, son of I.E. and F.P. King, 1891, [only date reported]
