**ORDER DENYING MOTION ENTITLED "JUDICIAL NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE FOR HONOR"**

BEFORE THE COURT is Movant Saldana's "Judicial Notice of Acceptance for Honor" ("*Motion*"), filed on May 14, 2007 [docket #155]. Therein, Movant appears to be trying to discharge his criminal conviction for corruptly endeavoring to obstruct and impede the due administration of Internal Revenue Laws in violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7212(a) and for filing false statements in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1001(a)(3). "Settlement of the account MO-03-CR-147(1)-RAJ has been done privately by exchanging my exemption for discharge of the obligation by use of my exemption Account No. 461192895, pursuant to HJR-192, Public Policy." *See Motion*, page 1, paragraph 2.

After due consideration, the Court finds that the *Motion* shall be denied as the Court finds it incomprehensible. This is a federal district court which does not discharge criminal convictions in exchange for exemptions and references to random account numbers.

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Movant's Motion is **DENIED as incomprehensible.**
