- + Example of the first: Acts 8 and the Ethiopian Treasurer
- + Example of the second from same chapter: Simon the Sorcerer; Acts 8:20-22
- + The confession we do **not** read about in the Scriptures:
- + The confession we do make in readiness to be baptized into Christ - (Rom. 6, Rom 10)

 - + 2) Repent
 - + 3) Confess faith in Christ
 - + 4) Baptism
